New **Malware** and **Viruses** are being added daily with every susceptible avenue being infiltrated.

A recent body of Malware takes advantage of your computer's Autorun feature. (E.g. when removable media CD/DVD/USB are inserted into a computer typically a program automatically launches. New software installations are most common.)

Roughly one tenth of all malware is designed to use portable storage media, such as removable USB drives, as an attack and spread point.

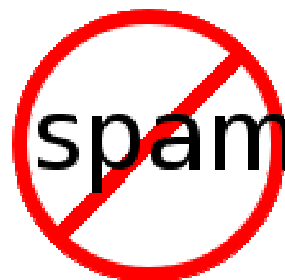

### **2009 Budget—A Good Time to Upgrade Your Computer Equipment**



Recent changes in the 2009 Federal Budget allow for accelerated capital cost allowance for computer equipment, including related systems software.

The budget temporarily increases the Capital Cost Allowance (CCA) rate to 100% for eligible computers and systems software acquired after January 27, 2009, and before February 2011.

Businesses will be entitled to a full deduction for the cost of

2011.  
Businesses will be entitled to a full deduction for the cost of these assets in the taxation year CCA is first available.

Eligible assets will include new computer equipment and software that is situated in Canada and acquired for use, or leased for use, in a business carried on in Canada or for the purpose of earning income from Canadian property.

The new tax measures will allow businesses to immediately acquire the technology they need to keep them competitive in today's challenging economic environment.
